Anti-ragging committee will function under the overall supervision of Prof. Pramod Kumar; Director. A daily report will be submitted to the Director by the Head of the Anti-Ragging Committee at 11:00 AM every day.

General Responsibility:

All the faculty members, senior students, and of the Institute shall have the collective responsibility in sensitizing the senior students and counseling the fresher's about their rights as bonafide students of the Institute and preventing the acts of ragging. They shall promptly and without fail report any act of ragging to the Head, Institute Anti Ragging Committee, verbally and in writing. If it is found that any person having knowledge of ragging has concealed any such information, action may be initiated against the person(s) concerned as per Institute regulations and the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Functions and Duties of Anti-ragging Squad:

1. To be vigilant at all hours including at odd hours all round the campus and other places vulnerable to incidents of, and having the potential of, ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
2. Conduct anonymous random surveys among fresher to check whether the campus is indeed free from ragging.
3. To conduct on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be; and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the anti-ragging committee for action under clause (a) of regulation 9.1 of U.G.C.
4. To ensure the display of posters/tabs on main and departmental notice boards and other places such as canteen, library, and sports lounge, gymnasium, Bus stops and other prominent designated places.
5. To monitor the welfare of fresh students outside the campus.
6. Any other activity the anti ragging committee might delegate to the squad.
7. To assist the Anti-Ragging Committee to faithfully implement the order of the Supreme Court.
8. To educate the Senior Students to help their junior students and not to indulge in acts of ragging.
9. To monitor and take all possible preventive measures to stop ragging of the students in the respective areas of the Tula's Institute.

CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN AICTE APPROVED TECHNICAL INSTITUTIONS

It is brought to the notice of the Institutions, students and other various stakeholders that ragging is a criminal offence and AICTE has framed regulation which has been notified vide F.No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated July 1, 2009 (available on AICTE web portal aicte-india.org) on curbing the menace of ragging in AICTE approved Technical Institution, in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in AICTE approved Technical Institutions.

The above regulation is mandatory and apply to all AICTE approved Institutions. All these Institutions should take necessary steps for its implementation, monitoring mechanism etc. as per provisions provided in the above regulation and ensure its strict compliance. Also following preventive measures for Anti-Ragging should be strictly followed by all AICTE approved Institutions:-

- (1) The Institutions may erect suitable hoardings/bill boards/banners in prominent places within the campus to exhort the students to prevent or not to indulge in ragging and also indicating therein the names of the officials and their telephone numbers to be contacted in case of ragging.
- (2) All Educational Institutions should form Anti-Ragging-Committee and Squads and dedicated Cadre of Wardens and Professional Counselors to ensure that the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Raghavan Committee recommendations are followed without exception.
- (3) Affidavit must be obtained from every Student, Parent/Guardian separately as per Clause 5, Sub-Clause 3 & 4 of AICTE regulation as cited above. Another affidavit must also be obtained along with application of Students while availing hostel accommodation as per Clause 5, Sub-Clause 6 of AICTE regulation as cited above.
- (4) The Institution may also undertake any other form of campaigns as it may consider appropriate for prevention of ragging.

Any violation of AICTE regulation as cited above by AICTE approved Institution or in case any Institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or act in accordance with these regulations or fails to punish perpetrators or incidents of ragging suitably, AICTE shall call for punitive action against erring Institutions.
